

CS260 Final Group Presentation

On Wednesday, January 22, 2014 beginning at 1PM, each group is to give a final 20-25 minute presentation, using PowerPoint, describing your Android Application.

Here are the specifics regarding the presentation:

1. Handout a one page ObjectAid UML diagram of all classes and their relationship used in the Android application prior to your presentation. Make sure the diagram is readable, the classes are well organized on the page, and the arrows don't criss cross all over the place.
2. Give a complete demo of your application so that we can know what the application does and how it works.
3. Using PowerPoint, present the following:
 - a) Each individual member of the group is to:
 - a. present the portion of the project worked on
 - b. talk about any new Android material learned
 - c. talk about the hardest part of the project
 - d. talk about the most fun part of the project
 - b) After each group member presents, then talk about:
 - a. How did your group decide to break up the project?
 - b. Did the design you turned in reflect the final design that was implemented?
 - c. Did the design help?
 - d. Would you do the design differently? If so, how?
 - e. How did your group put the project together development-wise and how did this process work? What problems did you run into?
 - f. As a group what would you do different?
