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1.8 The World Wide Web and Web Browsers

- The World Wide Web has become a popular means of sharing information on the Internet
- The Web and the Internet are not the same
 - WWW is a particular way to use the 'Net to share information
- Q1: What are some other examples of ways to share information online?

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Parts of the WWW

- Remember the client/server model?
- Web browser (client)
 - application on your local computer
 - displays web pages (HTML), images, etc

- Web server (server)
 - software that receives request from your web browsers
 - sends your computer web pages/images/etc

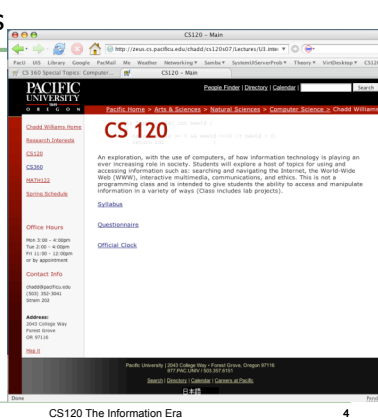
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Web pages

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Web Pages

- A web page is an ASCII text file in HTML form
- HTML: HyperText Markup Language
 - formatting information that tells the web browser how to display the information on the page
 - **bold**, *italics*, center, etc
 - hyperlinks to other web pages and data files

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URL

- Each web page has a unique URL (address)
 - Uniform Resource Locator
 - `http://zeus.cs.pacificu.edu/chadd/index.html`
 - What are the parts of the URL?
 - hostname?
 - domain name?
 - top level domain name?
 - what does `http://` mean?
 - what does `chadd/index.html` mean?
