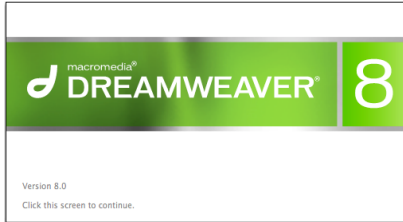

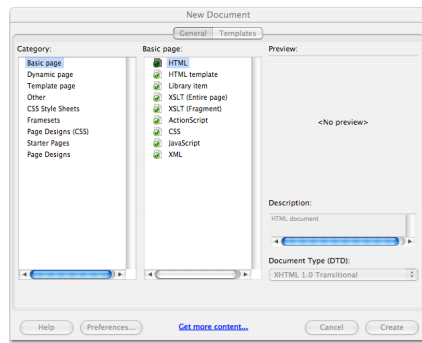

Let's Examine The Opening Screen

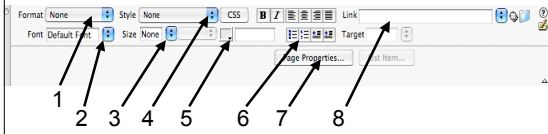

Selection Properties



- 1 Text formatting (heading, preformatted, ..)
- 2 Changes the font
- 3 Changes the size of the font
- 4 As you add colors, fonts, the styles show up here
- 5 Changes the color of the text
- 6 List types (ordered, unordered, indent, outdent)
- 7 Page properties provide for setting characteristics about an entire Web page
- 8 Link URL for selected text in a Web page

Dreamweaver Problem #1

- Let's begin using Dreamweaver by doing something we are familiar with which is to create the HTML INFORMATION, HTML TERMS, and HTML TAGS Web pages.
 1. Create a folder on your sites folder on Euler called dw1html (for dreamweaver html)
 2. Inside the folder, create htmlinfo.html, htmlterms.html, and htmltags.html from scratch using Dreamweaver 8

Dreamweaver Problem #1

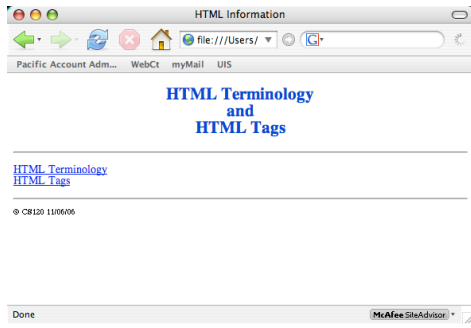
- Htmlinfo should contain:
 - A heading, centered at the top, in blue, that contains "HTML Terminology and HTML Tags"
 - A horizontal line
 - A link "HTML Terminology" that will open the htmlterms.html page
 - A link "HTML Tags" that will open the htmltags.html page
 - A horizontal line
 - A copyright at the bottom

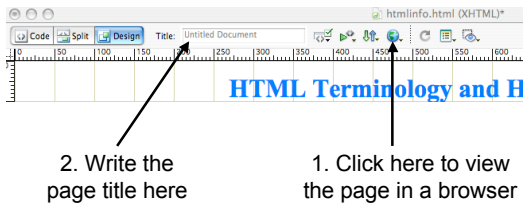

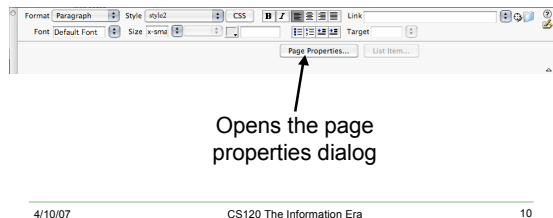
More HTML

2. How can you change the title of a page?

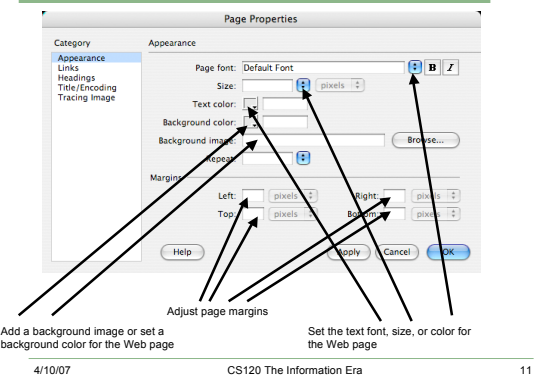


More HTML

- You can do this and many other things by going to the page properties



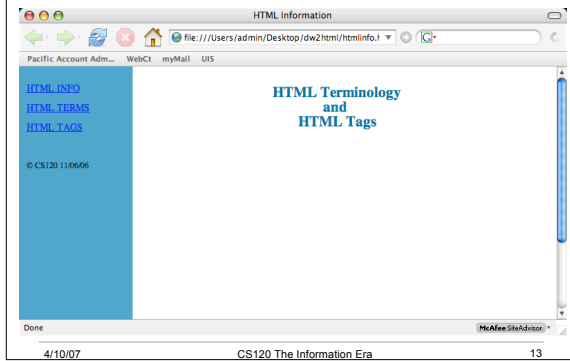
Page Properties

- Test your pages by viewing them in the browser

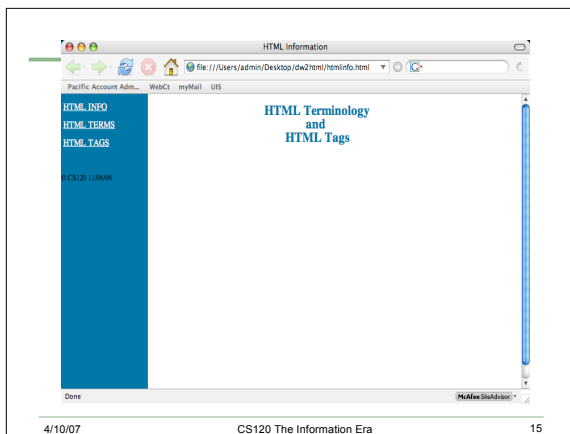
