The kinds of documentation that I'm looking for include, but are not limited to:

- Articles describing similar applications.
- Screenshots of similar applications.
- Resources on the technologies required for the project.
- List of books, articles, and websites that could be used for resources.
- A general description of the subject area.

Along with the supporting documentation, I would like you to type up your answers to the following questions:

- What topic do you propose to cover in your project?
- What is a potential title for your project?
- Why did you choose this topic? Why is it personally interesting?
- What do you already know about this topic?
- What difficulties do you foresee with this project?
- What rewards would you, and the community gain from your project?
